# **Missouri Collegiate DECA Chapter of the Year**



This award honors one Collegiate DECA chapter for their dedication to the organization. Each local chartered chapter is eligible to submit for Chapter of the Year. The recipient will receive a plaque, be recognized at the State Career Development Conference, and a letter of congratulations will be sent to the college administration.

## Eligibility:

- Must be a registered Missouri Collegiate Chartered Chapter
  - A charter requires a minimum of ten (10) registered members
- Have five (5) members complete the <u>Individual Leadership Passport</u> by February 1st, 2024.
- Chapter must have completed the <u>Chapter Leadership Passport Program</u> by February 1st, 2024
- Chapter President or Chapter Advisor must complete one letter on why your chapter should be named Chapter of the year.
  - Specific items to be addressed are found on the following page (*Scoring Guide on page 2*).
  - 250 word minimum and double spaced

### Guidelines

- The combined score from the letter and activities documented through the Chapter Leadership Passport will be used to determine the Chapter of the Year.
  - o Letter 40 points
  - o Chapter Leadership Passport Entries 60 points
- The letter must be emailed by the Advisor or Chapter President to <u>leslie.crider@dese.mo.gov</u>.
- The letter must be received by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.
- The letter must address the prompts on page 2 of this document.
- The Chapter Leadership Passport will need to be submitted through the <u>national portal</u> by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
- Missouri Collegiate DECA will request from DECA Inc., all the submissions for Chapter Leadership Passport on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024.
