### **Eligibility:**

- Must be a registered Missouri Collegiate Chartered Chapter Member
  - A charter requires a minimum of 10 registered members
- Member must have completed the <u>Individual Leadership Passport Program</u> by February 1st, 2024
- Chapter must have completed the Chapter Leadership Passport Program by February 1st, 2024
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a current Missouri Collegiate DECA Chapter advisor
  - o Specific items to be addressed are found on the following page (Scoring Guide on page 2).
  - 250 word minimum and double spaced

#### **Guidelines**

- The combined score from the advisor letter of recommendation and activities documented through the Individual Leadership Passport will be used to determine the Member of the Year.
  - o Student Letter of Recommendation 40 points
  - Chapter Leadership Passport Entries 60 points
- The letter of recommendation must be emailed by the advisor making the recommendation to leslie.crider@dese.mo.gov.
- The letter must be received by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.
- The letter must address the prompts on page 2 of this document.
- The Individual Leadership Passport will need to be submitted through the <u>national portal</u> by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
- Missouri Collegiate DECA will request from DECA Inc., all the submissions for Individual Leadership Passport on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024.
- The scoring rubric for Leadership Passport activities is on page 3 of this document.
