STUDENT

CONFERENCE MANAGEMENT

SUPERVISION

The supervision ratio for this conference is one advisor for every ten students. If you wish to assign students to another advisor outside of your school district for supervision purposes, complete and return the "Agreement to Supervise" form. Otherwise, one person who is approved by your school district must accompany every ten students.

DUTIES

Advisors and chaperones will be assigned duties to help with the management and operation of the conference.

VOTING DELEGATES

Each DECA Chapter attending the conference has 2 voting delegates to select their District Vice President.

APPLICATIONS

All potential candidates must submit an application to the state office. Chapter Advisors please print & read the letter before giving the application to interested students. The application packet is available on the Missouri DECA website under the "Students and State Officer Applicants" tab. You may also direct interested candidates to the website and click on "State Officers". Applications for State Officer Candidates are due to the State Office via email or mailed with a postmarked on or before September 30, 2023.

District Vice Presidents responsibilities include:

- Assisting with all District DECA Activities (for example District CDC, State CDC district meetings)
- Communicating regularly with State Officers to engage their district in any state-wide initiative
- Attend FLC, November 8 DVP training in Jefferson City, SCDC is paid for all DVP's as they will help lead the conference
- DVP's will be taking the place of one of three Leadership Delegates for each district, therefore eligible to attend ICDC.

CONFERENCE CHECK-IN

<u>All advisors</u> are required to register in the Parasol I Meeting Room at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

POLICIES

DRESS CODE

Students, advisors, and chaperones shall adhere to the dress code requirements for the entirety of the conference. The Chapter Advisor is responsible for communicating the dress code requirements to all conference attendees and for ensuring compliance with the rules established for proper dress.

Missouri DECA maintains a quality learning environment for conference participants. Dress should not distract from the learning environment. Participants should use good judgment when deciding what to wear.

<u>October 29 Dress Code: Jeans and DECA T-shirt:</u> This year, participants are allowed to wear a DECA t-shirt and nice jeans (with no holes) for the entire Sunday agenda. No sweats, shorts, etc.

October 30 Dress Code: Professional Business Attire:

Females: Business suit or blazer with dress blouse and dress skirt or dress slacks or business dress: dress shoes.

All skirts and dresses must be at or below the knee.

Male: Business suit or sport coat with dress slacks, collard dress shirt and necktie, dress shoes and dress socks.

NO ALCOHOL OR NARCOTICS

No alcoholic beverages or narcotics in any form shall be possessed by delegates at the Missouri DECA Fall Leadership and District VP Election Conference. See Item 6 on the Delegate Code of Conduct Practices and Procedures.

No smoking OR vaping is allowed at the Missouri DECA Fall Leadership and State Officer Election Conference. Smoking is a violation of Item 7 on the Delegate Code of Conduct Practices and Procedures.
