- 2. You will be required to participate in a candidates' interviewing process which will be held on via zoom during the week of February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Deliver a brief statement (3-5 minutes maximum) to the delegation at the Opening General Session. The content of the message should include introductory information, reasons for interest in the position, qualifications, and describe your involvement in Collegiate DECA. You may use note cards.
- 4. At competition, you may use your time when you are not competing to meet with students on a one-on-one basis to share your personal brand and why you would like to be a State Officer.
- After all candidates deliver his/her statement, voting delegates will cast their ballots for the State President. The candidate with the most votes will be the 2023-2024 President and the person with the second highest amount of votes will be Vice-President.
